Mental health can positively or negatively impact your physical health and risk factors for heart disease and stroke. Stress may contribute to poor health behaviors linked to increased risk for heart disease and stroke, such as:

Smoking + Overeating + Lack of physical activity + Unhealthy diet + Being overweight +Not taking medications as prescribed

Here are some ways you can manage stress, anxiety, grief, or worry:

- Take breaks from news stories, including those on social media. It's good to be informed, but constant information about negative events can be upsetting.
- Take care of your body: Staying physically healthy can improve your emotional well-being. Here are some ways to improve your health:
- REFINE THE ALLOW VEGETABLES, lean protein, whole grains, and low-tat or no-fat dairy. Limit foods with unhealthy fats, salt, and added sugars.
 Get enough sleep. Go to bed and wake up at the same time each day to help you sleep better. Adults need 7 or more hours per night.
 Move more and sit less Every little bits
 - and build up to 2 ¹/₂ hours a week. You can break it into smaller amounts such as 20 to 30 minutes a day.
 - Connect with others.
 - Talk with people you trust about your concerns and how you are feeling. Ο




