DID you Know that April is Autism Acceptance Month?

Brought to you by: FHCOC Care Team Ministry

There is no medical autism test, like a blood test, to diagnose autism spectrum disorder (ASD). Instead, experienced medical professionals examine a person's developmental history and behavior, interview and observe the person and their loved ones, and use professional screening and diagnostic tools to make a diagnosis.

Autism screening tools:

- For ages 16 to 30 months- The M-CHAT-R is a free parent completed questionnaire with 20 questions regarding your child's behavior.
- For ages 12 to 60 months The SACS-R and SACS-PR are autism screening tools developed by La Trobe University designed to identify behaviors that are characteristics of children as young as 12 months old through preschool.
- For school-aged children Developed to be taken by parents, educators and medical professionals, Southwest Autism Research & Resource Center's (SARRC) 15 questions Social Challenges Screening Questionnaire can identify children
- For ages 16 + years The Autism Spectrum Quotient Test- is a self-administered 50- questions questionnaire used to measure autistic traits in adolescents and adults aged 16+; IQ over 80.


