Healthy Skin Month

Skin is the largest organ of the body and plays an important protective role. It holds body fluids in, prevents dehydration, and keeps harmful germs out. Healthy skin is important because it can prevent sickness or damage to the bones, muscles, and internal organs.

Skin Facts:

- The average adult has approximately 16 22 square feet of skin, which weighs around 9 – 11 lbs.
 - Skin accounts for ~15% of your body weight.
- The skin has three layers: epidermis, dermis, and subcutis.
- The thickness of the skin varies between different parts of the body
 - Skin is thickest on the palms and soles and thinnest on the eyelids.
- The skin completely renews itself every 28 days by constantly shedding dead cells.
 - Skin sheds around 30,000 cells per minute.




