- Medicaid covers over 30 million women nationwide.
- Most women on Medicaid are working or have caretaking responsibilities.
- Medicaid is a major source of coverage for women of color.
- Medicaid covers nearly half of the women with disabilities.
- Over 50 Percent of American children are enrolled in Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP).
- More than four in 10 Births are covered by Medicaid.
- Medicaid helps pay for long-term care, mostly for elderly women.






