Parkinson's disease (PD) is a type of movement disorder that is a chronic and progressive disease, meaning that the symptoms become worse over time. It is characterized by its most common of motor symptoms—<u>tremors</u> (a form of rhythmic shaking), stiffness or rigidity of the muscles, and slowness of movement (called bradykinesia)—but also manifests in non-motor symptoms including <u>sleep problems</u>, <u>constipation</u>, <u>anxiety</u>, <u>depression</u>, and <u>fatique</u>, among others.

#### CAUSES:

The cause of Parkinson's disease is still unknown, although there is some evidence for the role of genetics, environmental factors, or a combination of both. It is also possible that there may be more than one cause of the disease. Scientists generally believe that both genetics and environment interact to cause Parkinson's disease in most people who have it.


#### **DIAGNOSING:**

While there is no definitive test that can be taken to determine whether a person has Parkinson's disease, movement disorder specialists look for symptoms and use brain imaging technology to accurately diagnose Parkinson's.

#### TREATMENT:

While there is no cure for Parkinson's at this time, there are a number of treatments that can ease symptoms. Parkinson's medications are the mainstay of treatment, but modalities are often used in combination. Physical, occupational, and speech therapy can be critical to the treatment plan. Surgical options also have an important role for a subset of patients with Parkinson's disease.
