



Did you know?

SYMPTOMS:

Signs and symptoms of sarcoidosis vary widely depending on the organs affected. While many people who have sarcoidosis have very few or no signs of the disease, others suffer debilitating effects that can interfere with daily life.

April is Sarcoidosis Awareness Month

Sarcoidosis (pronounced SAR-COY-DOE-SIS) is an inflammatory disease characterized by the formation of

granulomas—tiny clumps of inflammatory cells—in one or more organs of the body. When the immune system goes into overdrive and too many of these clumps form, they can interfere with an organ's structure and function.

When left unchecked, chronic inflammation can lead to fibrosis, which is the permanent scarring of organ tissue.

When patients are first diagnosed, they often present with a classic set of signs described as **Lofgren's Syndrome**: Fever * Enlarged lymph nodes * Swollen and painful joints, arthritis * Erythema nodosum, raised, red, and tender bumps to form on the skin, usually on the front of the legs. Nearby joints are often swollen and painful. * Because sarcoidosis so often affects the lungs, other common symptoms of sarcoidosis include shortness of breath, wheezing, and chronic cough. Some patients will also experience chest pain and others will have no signs at all, even when inflammation is present.

TREATMENT:

Medical treatment can be used to control symptoms, prevent complications, and improve outcomes in patients with persistent sarcoidosis.

Corticosteroids- Corticosteroids reduce inflammation. • Immune system suppressant medication- Because sarcoidosis may be the result of an overreaction of the immune system, suppressing the immune system may ease symptoms and prevent further organ damage. • Antimalarial drugs - As a treatment for sarcoidosis, these drugs are most likely to be effective in people who have skin symptoms or a high level of calcium in their blood.
