Cope With
Depression
During the
Holiday
Season



Brought to you by: FHCOC Care Team Ministry Despite the bright lights and festive cheer that accompany the winter holidays, this time of year can bring about feelings of loneliness, isolation, grief, and sadness, both for people with clinical depression and even for some who aren't depressed.

- 1. Stay Active and Get Outdoors: Moving your body is one of the best science-backed ways to cope with depression during any season, and the holidays are no exception.
- **2. Share How You're Feeling With Trusted Loved Ones:** Akua Boateng, Ph.D., a Philadelphia-based psychotherapist, recommends surrounding yourself with people you can rely on during the holidays whether it be family or friends to help manage holiday depression.
- 3. Assess Your Relationships and Set Boundaries: Boateng suggests monitoring your emotions around different people in your life and setting boundaries accordingly. This could mean limiting the time you spend during the holidays with people who cause you to feel negative emotions or exacerbate your depressive symptoms and establishing boundaries for your interactions with and availability to those people, she says.
- 4. Consider Volunteering Throughout the Holiday Season
- **5. Create a Coping Sheet or Depression Toolkit:** A coping sheet is a list of favorite activities you can turn to when you're feeling depressed.


