#### MORE ACTIONS TOWARD BETTER HEALTH

Get Enough Good-Quality Sleep

Sleep helps heal and repair your heart and blood vessels. It also helps:

- Maintain a healthy balance of the hormones that make you feel hungry or full
- Support healthy growth and development
- Support a healthy immune system

Over time, not getting enough quality sleep, called sleep deficiency, can raise your risk of <u>heart</u> <u>disease</u>, <u>obesity</u>, <u>high blood pressure</u>, diabetes, and <u>stroke</u>.

This table shows recent American <u>Academy of Sleep Medicine (AASM)</u> recommendations that the American

|                                   | Children 3 – 5 years     | 10 -13 (including naps)          |
|                                   | Children 6 – 12 years    | 9 – 12                           |
|                                   | Children 13 – 18 years   | 8 – 10                           |

#### ALSO:

- Spend time outside every day, if possible, and be physically active.
- Avoid nicotine and caffeine.
- Avoid heavy or large meals within a couple of hours before bedtime.
- Avoid alcoholic drinks before bed.
- Go to bed and wake up at the same time every day.
- Use the hour before bed for quiet time. Avoid exercise and bright light.
- Take a hot bath or use relaxation techniques before bed.
- Keep your bedroom quiet, cool, and dark.






