Top 5 Cancer Screenings That Should Be On Your Radar In 2024



Brought to you by: FHCOC Care Team Ministry The new year often brings about new health goals, and one goal everyone should consider adding to their list is scheduling screenings for cancer.
1. Mammogram: A mammogram takes an X-ray picture of the breast, so doctors can analyze the breast for early signs of breast cancer. Getting regular mammograms allows doctors to compare changes in breasts and allows them to find breast cancer early.

2. Cervical cancer screening: Cervical cancer screening usually begins after the age of 18 and women can obtain a Pap smear evaluation along with testing for HPV DNA to assess for a higher risk of developing cervical cancer.

3. Prostate cancer screening: A prostate-specific antigen (PSA) blood test detects PSA, which is a protein made by cells in the prostate gland (both normal cells and cancer cells).
4. Colorectal screenings: The U.S. Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF) recommends that both men and women aged 45 to 75 be screened for colorectal cancer. Those older than 75 and those at increased risk for colorectal cancer should talk to their doctor.
5. Lung cancer screening: The USPSTF recommends that people who match the below criteria get lung cancer screening once a year:

- Have a 20-pack-year or more smoking history (for example, one pack a day for 20 years or two packs a day for 10 years), and
- Currently smoke or are a former smoker who quit within the past 15 years, and
- Are between 50 and 80 years old






