

Specific Persons, Fear, and Harassment

- <u>Stalking is typically directed at a specific person the victim</u>. However, stalkers often contact the victim's family, friends and/or coworkers as part of their pattern of behavior.
- <u>Anyone can be a victim of stalking</u>. A majority of stalking victims are stalked by someone they know: a current or former intimate partner, acquaintance, or family member.
- <u>The majority of stalking victims are female</u>. However, people of all genders can be stalked. It is estimated that 1 in 3 women and 1 in 6 men will experience stalking in their lifetime.
- <u>Many stalkers' behaviors seem innocuous or even desirable to outsiders</u> for example, sending expensive gifts. The stalker's actions don't seem scary and are hard to explain.
- Fear is contextual. What's scary to one person may not be scary to another. In stalking cases, many of the behaviors are only scary to a victim because of their relationship with the stalker.
- <u>Stalking and harassment are similar and can overlap</u>. Harassment may be part of a stalking pattern of behavior/course of conduct.

Brought to you by: FHCOC Care Team Ministry <u>Generally, the element of fear is what separates stalking from harassment</u>. Harassment is typically irritating and bothersome, sometimes to the point where a victim feels deeply uncomfortable. However, victims of harassment are not typically afraid of their perpetrators.
