

#### **ULTRAVIOLET (UV) RAYS**

#### Ultraviolet Rays:

- Ultraviolet rays are shorter light waves that are produced by the sun. People cannot see ultraviolet rays, but some insects like bees can.
  - UVA damages your skin, resulting in a tan. It is the primary radiation used in tanning beds. It causes almost all forms of skin aging, including wrinkles. UVA damages the collagen and elastin in the skin and also generates free radicals.
- Most skin cancers are caused by too much exposure to ultraviolet (UV) rays.

#### Protection:

- Simply **staying in the shade** is one of the best ways to limit your UV exposure. If you are going to be in the sun, "Slip! Slop! Slap!<sup>®</sup> and Wrap" is a catchphrase that can help you remember some of the key steps you can take to protect yourself from UV rays:
  - $_{\circ}$  Slip on a shirt.
  - Slop on sunscreen.
  - Slap on a hat.
  - Wrap on sunglasses to protect the eyes and skin around them.




