


Attention Parents!

Cataract Awareness Month

CATARACT AWARENESS MONTH

A cataract is a clouding of the normally clear lens of the eye. For people who have cataracts, seeing through cloudy lenses is a bit like looking through a frosty or fogged-up window. Clouded vision caused by cataracts can make it more difficult to read, drive a car (especially at night) or see the expression on a friend's face.

Cataract is the world's leading cause of blindness, accounting for approximately 42 percent of all cases of blindness in all nations.


Risk factors for <u>cataracts</u> include:

- Older age
- Intense heat or long-term exposure to UV rays from the sun
- Certain diseases, such as diabetes
- Inflammation in the eye
- Hereditary influences
- Events before birth, such as German measles in the mother
- Long-term steroid use
- Eye injuries
- Eye diseases
- Smoking

Signs and symptoms of cataracts include:

- $_{\circ}$ $\,$ Clouded, blurred or dim vision
- Increasing difficulty with vision at night
- Sensitivity to light and glare
- Need for brighter light for reading and other activities
- Seeing "halos" around lights
- Frequent changes in eyeglass or contact lens prescription
- Fading or yellowing of colors
- $_{\circ}$ $\,$ Double vision in a single eye $\,$
