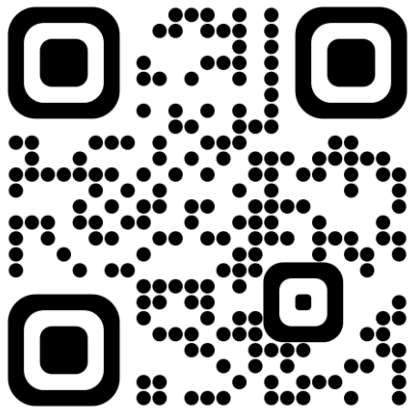

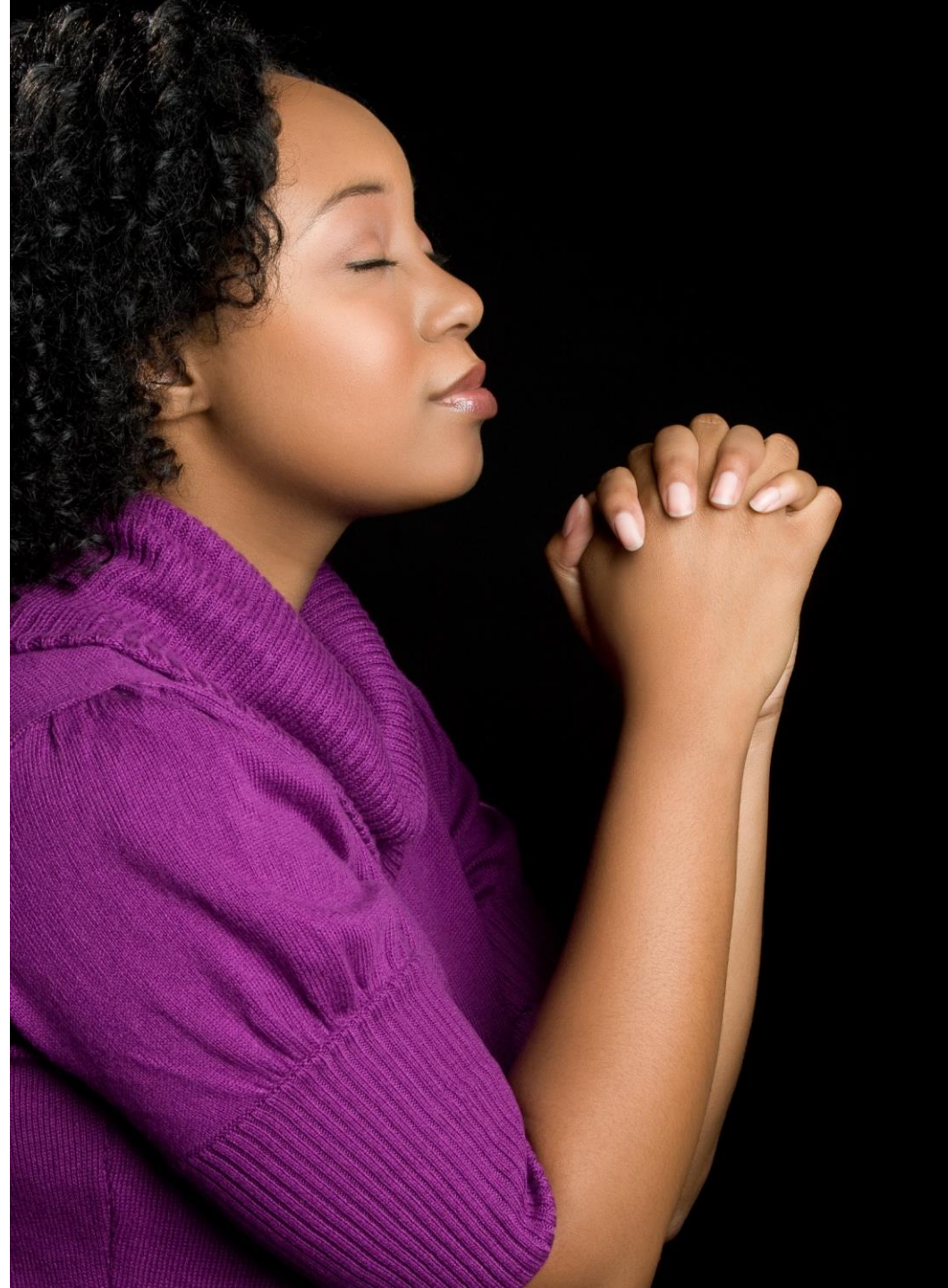

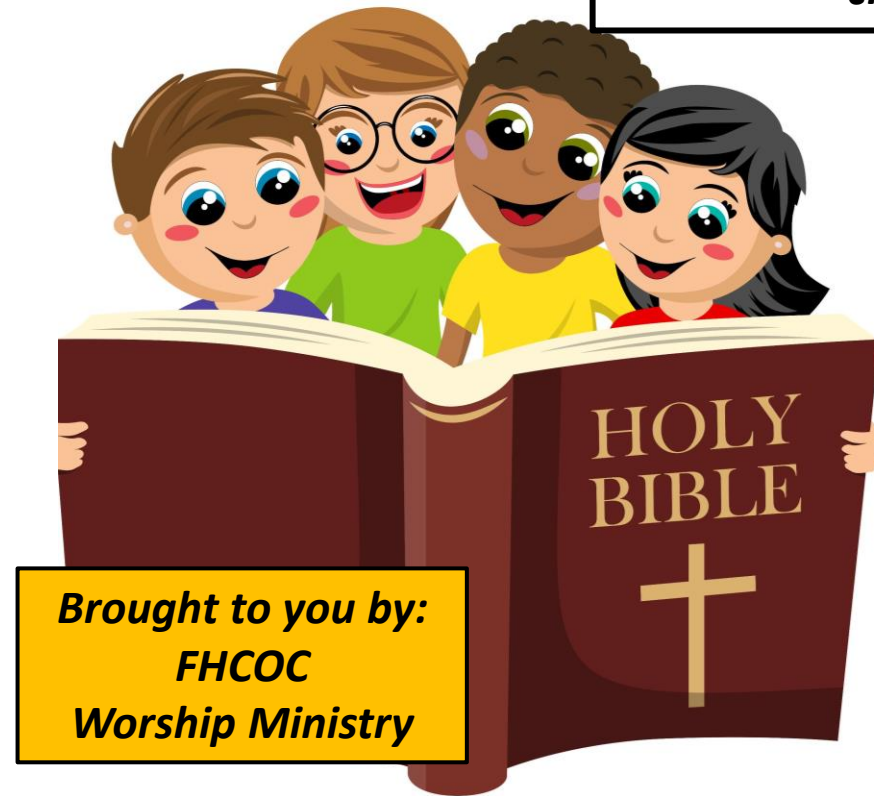
If you have a child between the ages of 4 through 9, please bring them to the Children's Bible Hour Class during the worship service (in the classroom next to the nursery).

Cord Blood Awareness

Cord blood is the blood from the baby that is left in the umbilical cord and placenta after birth. It contains special cells called hematopoietic stem cells that can be used to treat many diseases.

Hematopoietic stem cells can be used to treat more than 70 types of diseases, including diseases of the immune system, genetic disorders, neurologic disorders, and some forms of cancer, including leukemia and lymphoma.

Cord blood is collected by an obstetrician–gynecologist (ob-gyn) or the staff at the hospital where the baby is born.

Cord blood is kept in one of two types of banks - public or private.

- Public cord blood banks store cord blood for allogenic transplants (transplant where donated tissue, organs, or cells come from another person). They do not charge to store cord blood.
- Private or family banks store cord blood for autologous use or directed donation for a family member. Private banks charge a yearly fee for storage.

Why be aware? To understand how valuable this is and to know how cord blood have blessed so many lives.

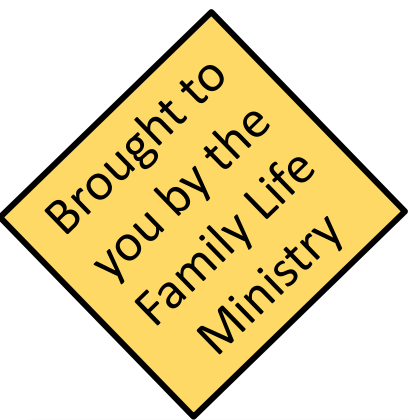
