




Praise God! Chloee' Skinner





More About Colorectal Cancer

Colorectal cancer almost always develops from precancerous polyps (abnormal growths) in the colon or rectum. Screening tests can find precancerous polyps so that they can be removed before they turn into cancer. Screening tests can also find colorectal cancer early when treatment works best.

Talk with your doctor about a screening method that is appropriate for you.

Discuss the nature of the screening, the frequency with which you should screen, the pros and cons of various screenings, and each method's sensitivity and specificity for detecting cancer.

Here are some common screening methods for finding precancerous polyps.

Colonoscopy
Stool DNA

Fecal Immunochemical Test (FIT or iFBOT)
Guaiac Fecal Occult Blood Test (FBOT)
Flexible Sigmoidoscopy
Virtual Colonoscopy
Double Contrast Barium Enema








Evangelism Outreach Brunch




