





Did you know?

Polycystic Ovarian Syndrome

Polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS) is a condition in which the ovaries produce an abnormal amount of androgens, male sex hormones that are usually present in women in small amounts. The name polycystic ovary syndrome describes the numerous small cysts (fluid-filled sacs) that form in the ovaries. However, some women with this disorder do not have cysts, while some women without the disorder do develop cysts.

SEPTEMBER IS



Causes:

The exact cause of PCOS is not clear. Many women with PCOS have insulin resistance. This means the body can't use insulin well. Insulin levels build up in the body and may cause higher androgen levels. Obesity can increase insulin levels making PCOS symptoms worse.

AWARENESS MONTH PCOS may also run in families. It's common for sisters or a mother & daughter to have PCOS. **Symptoms:**

Missed periods, irregular periods, or very light periods ● Ovaries that are large or have many cysts • Excess body hair, including the chest, stomach, and back (hirsutism) • Weight gain, especially around the belly (abdomen) ● Acne or oily skin ● Male-pattern baldness or thinning hair • Infertility • Small pieces of excess skin on the neck or armpits (skin tags) ● Dark or thick skin patches on the back of the neck, in the armpits, and under the breasts
