

Especially pray for the one who witnessed the accident first-hand and lost his two closest friends.





Blood Cancer

Most blood cancers, also called hematologic cancers, start in the bone marrow, where blood cells are produced. Blood cancers occur when abnormal blood cells grow out of control, interfering with the function of normal blood cells, which fight off infection and produce new blood cells.

Types of blood cancer:

The three main types of blood and bone marrow cancer are <u>leukemia</u>, <u>lymphoma and myeloma</u>.

- <u>Leukemia</u> is a blood cancer that <u>originates in the blood and bone marrow</u>. It occurs when the body creates too many abnormal white blood cells and interferes with the bone marrow's ability to make red blood cells and platelets.
- Non-Hodgkin lymphoma is a blood cancer that develops in the lymphatic system from cells called lymphocytes, a type of white blood cell that helps the body fight infections.
- Hodgkin lymphoma is a blood cancer that develops in the lymphatic system from cells called lymphocytes. Hodgkin lymphoma is characterized by the presence of an abnormal lymphocyte called the Reed-Sternberg cell.
- Multiple myeloma is a blood cancer that begins in the blood's plasma cells, a type of white blood cell made in the bone marrow.

Blood cancer symptoms – Some common bone marrow and blood cancer symptoms include:

Fever ♦ Chills ♦ Persistent Fatigue ♦ Weakness ♦ Loss of Appetite ♦ Nausea ♦ Unexplained Weight Loss ♦ Night Sweats




