- Black Women Face Three Times the Maternal Mortality Risk as White Women
- Even more concerning, however, is that the overall maternal mortality rate masks stark disparities by race and ethnicity.
- Due to systemic racism and discrimination at the individual level, Black women and birthing people face unacceptable (and mostly <u>preventable</u>) risk during childbirth and throughout and after pregnancy.
- It must also be noted that Hispanic women saw the largest maternal mortality increase of any racial or ethnic demographic group in the study, rising by a staggering 44 percent in just one year.
