April 11-17 is
***Black Maternal
Health Week???***

- *Black Women Face Three Times the Maternal Mortality Risk as White Women*
- *Even more concerning, however, is that the overall maternal mortality rate masks stark disparities by race and ethnicity.*
- *Due to systemic racism and discrimination at the individual level, Black women and birthing people face unacceptable (and mostly preventable) risk during childbirth and throughout and after pregnancy.*
- *It must also be noted that Hispanic women saw the largest maternal mortality increase of any racial or ethnic demographic group in the study, rising by a staggering 44 percent in just one year.*
