Did you know? March is National Colorectal Cancer Month.



Brought to you by: FHCOC Care Team Ministry Colorectal cancer starts in the colon or the rectum. These cancers can also be called colon cancer or rectal cancer, depending on where they start. Colon cancer and rectal cancer are often grouped together because they have many features in common.

The colon and rectum:

. The colon and rectum make up the large intestine (or large bowel), which is part of the digestive system, also called the gastrointestinal (GI) system.

How do the colon and rectum work?

- . Most of the large intestine is made up of the colon, a muscular tube about 5 feet (1.5 meters) long.
- . The colon absorbs water and salt from the remaining food matter after it goes through the small intestine (small bowel).
- The waste matter that's left after going through the colon goes into the rectum, the final 6 inches (15cm) of the digestive system.
- . It's stored there until it passes through the anus.
- . Ring-shaped muscles (also called **sphincters**) around the anus keep stool from coming out until they relax during a bowel movement.
